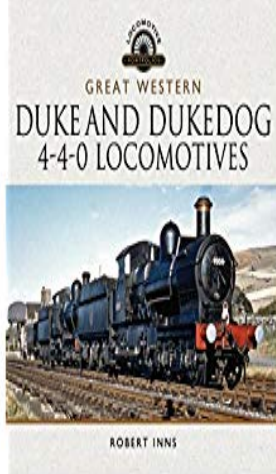


The Great Western Railway Duke and Dukedog 4-4-0 Locomotives



The Duke class, introduced in 1825, was the first class of 4-4-0s to be built in a large quantity by the Great Western Railway. This remarkable book tells their story. The Great Western Railway Class (or 'Earl' Class) was a design of steam locomotive for passenger train work. The nickname for this class, almost universally used at the time these engines were in service was Dukedog since the locomotives were composed of former Duke. The Great Western Railway or Duke Class were steam locomotives with outside frames and parallel domed boilers. They were built in five batches.
