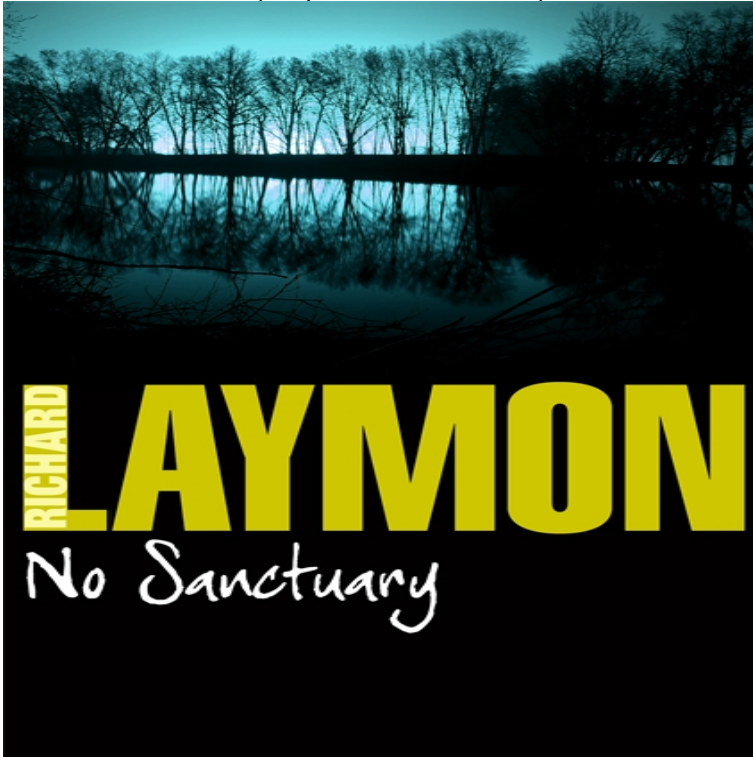


## No Sanctuary: (Richard Laymon Horror Classic)
